If you are a probationary member and need to fulfill an obligation, there is a sign-up sheet for club grass cutting on the bulletin board. I takes about two hours.

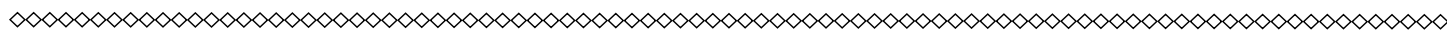

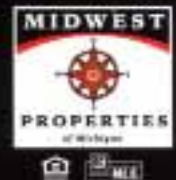
